And yet there is one resolution we passed in 2022 that is near and dear to my heart that I hope Staff Senate will continue to pursue. I have spoken about it to every administrator and at every Board of Supervisors meeting, including the one last Thursday: Calling for the Review and Elimination of Fees for Staff Enrolled in Tuition Exemption.

I arrived on campus in 1997 with a high school diploma. I'd always wanted to attend college, but there was no TOPS program at that time and the cost was beyond what my mom could afford, so I started a career instead. Let me begin by telling you how appreciative I am of the tuition exemption program. It allowed me to earn a bachelor's degree from the Manship School in mass communication, a master's in public administration, and on August 11, I will receive my doctoral degree and be hooded. High school diploma to Dr. Tammy Millican, a first-gen graduate.

There's a point to me sharing this with you. It was hard financially. Not as much in the beginning when it was \$200 for two classes, but as that cost began to increase in response to the change in the State funding formula for higher education, it became more and more difficult, especially with a young family and during a time when we weren't receiving pay raises, to afford classes.

The same struggle goes on today but at a much higher cost, so I hope Staff Senate continues this fight. A bill was passed during this legislative session that waives fees for all veterans who receive tuition benefits and I applaud that decision. It is my hope that as we now see that it can happen that it will happen for staff too.

Personally, this has been a great year for me. I celebrated 25 years at the university I love and finished my PhD. I had the opportunity to serve with you on Staff Senate and in a complete shocker I received the Kiwanis Club Distinguished Service Award.

I am so happy where we stand as a Staff Senate today. I truly believe we've earned the respect of those we serve, but there's more work to be done. Committees are where the magic happens, so my hope is that next year's Senators hit the ground running on initiatives and events. I hope that we continue to grow our relationship with the administration, Faculty Senate, and Student Government. I also hope Staff Appreciation Week this year blows the previous one out of the water, but none of this happens without your help. You've been elected to advocate, bring awareness, and show appreciation for your colleagues. Let's do that. Finally, I would like to show my appreciation for this incredibly hard-working group of Exec members.

Henri (Treasurer) - You are the perfect combination of financial leadership and fun. She shows up and works hard at everything we did this year, and I appreciate that so much.

Quinneka (Secretary) - You came to every meeting with the best ideas and thoughtful feedback AND you're adding two baby Staff Senators to our Senate this year. Congratulations and thank you for serving.

Valori (Member-at-Large) - You are a leader, period. Not only did you bring in issues, but you also developed solutions, and then implemented them.
